Although [3H]RILP binds to both the beta 2- and beta 1-subunits of brain G-proteins, only the beta 2-subunit selectively modulates GTP binding to Gs. Restriction of prenylation of G-proteins, a posttranslational modification required for their functions in neuronal cells, decreases in vitro GTP binding to the GTP-binding protein of adenylyl cyclase (Gs). We have previously shown that protein farnesyltransferase inhibitors inhibit adenylyl cyclase activity in a manner compatible with the requirement for prenylation of G-proteins. In the present study, we examine the effects of the addition of protein farnesyltransferase inhibitors on [3H]RILP binding to both the beta 2- and beta 1-subunits of G-proteins from bovine cerebellar membranes. We find that in the absence of protein farnesyltransferase inhibitors, [3H]RILP binds to both beta 2- and beta 1-subunits, and that both the beta 2- and beta 1-subunits are prenylated. However, only the beta 2-subunit selectively modulates GTP binding to Gs. These results suggest that the predominant form of G-proteins in brain, the beta 2-subunit, is also the form that participates in the prenylation of G-proteins in brain.
