Sally Keeble, who represents Newport West, says that means "an alternative will emerge" to Mr Corbyn. But Mr Williamson, himself a former Labour leader and MP, says "we are not going to get that far". In the last election, Labour increased its vote share by two million, he says. "I'm not in favour of the way in which we got into the situation we got into," he said. "The referendum caused us to switch from being clearly the party of Labour voters, to a party of working class voters and it did not change the course of the election at all." He says there was "no evident logic to the decision" to support the government's flagship Brexit legislation, the Withdrawal Agreement. "I think the facts have now sunk in - this is a terrible, terrible deal. "I don't see how anyone can support it. "We are voting against the deal the government has done and voted for in the last election and a number of us are trying to get the leadership to do the same." He says he thinks some of those who do back a referendum may be split between Mr Corbyn and Mr Smith, who are both supportive of leaving the EU. His fellow leadership contender, John McDonnell, has been more cautious in his comments on a second referendum - suggesting it may be a good idea but not necessarily a priority for Labour's policy.
