They can be moved, copied, modified, resized, and exported as a DGN,

DWG, DXF, DWF, and (most recently) PDF file. AutoCAD can also generate standard 2D vector graphics (such as EPS) and shapefiles. AutoCAD can be used to document and coordinate the development of a project. In addition, AutoCAD is also capable of managing large and complex projects in conjunction with a wide variety of file types (ARCHI, GBS, AutoCAD LT, Revit, SolidWorks, and others), and storing these drawings in

the.dwg format. It also includes a shape tracing technology.

AutoCAD includes plug-ins to support importing and exporting in a number of file formats.

Importing a DWG file will often export it to a PDF or other format. AutoCAD 2020, released in June 2015, has various features, including more sophisticated (and powerful) drawing techniques such as the introduction of a 3D wireframe mode, improvements in the

handling of multiple views, and new views and symbols.

AutoCAD users are also able to import DXF, DWG and DWF files into a new document type, the DWG-XML DWG file.

AutoCAD is available on multiple platforms, including macOS, iOS, and Android. It was first released on the Mac in 1987, with a Windows port released in 1990. The Android AutoCAD Application is available for download on the
